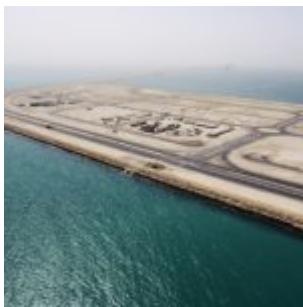




[King Fahad Causeway](#)

Khalifa bin Salman Port (KBSP) which opened for business on April 1, 2009 is well positioned to be the premier transshipment hub for the Northern Gulf.
