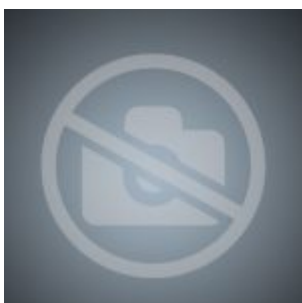

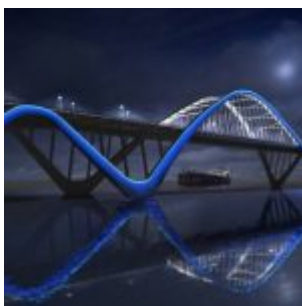

Proposed causeway between Bahrain and Qatar.

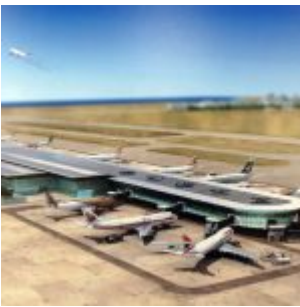

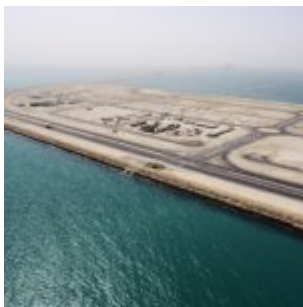
